**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Planning Commission of the City of Desert Hot Springs will hold a public hearing on **January 10, 2012, at 6:00 PM**, in the Carl May Community Center, 11711 West Drive, Desert Hot Springs, California to consider the following matter:

A Mitigated Negative Declaration and Mitigation Monitoring Program, Development Review 07-11, Design Review 05-11, and Conditional Use Permit 07-11, for Mark S. Shirilau/Aloha Systems to construct two (2) adjacent 1.47 megawatt ground-mounted photovoltaic plants on a 14.4-acre site located at 64801 Dillon Road, approximately 500 feet west of Little Morongo Road, in the City of Desert Hot Springs.

The City of Desert Hot Springs encourages interested parties to attend the public hearing and to comment on the issues being discussed. If you wish to provide testimony and are unable to attend the meeting, written comments that are delivered to the City Clerk's office prior to the time of the hearing will be made a part of the public record. 

