NOTICE OF VACANCIES ARCHITECTURAL & LANDSCAPE REVIEW COMMITTEE

Pursuant to §2.24.030 of the City of Desert Hot Springs ("City") Municipal Code, notice is hereby given that three (3) vacancies exist on the City's Architectural & Landscape Review Committee (ALRC).

ABOUT THE ALRC:

The ALRC shall consist of three (3) members appointed by a majority vote of the City Council. The terms of the Committee members are as follows: two (2) members (Chair and Vice-Chair) having two (2) year terms and one (1) general member having a one (1) year term.

On an as needed basis, regularly scheduled meetings of the ALRC shall be held on the first and third Thursdays of each month at 2:00 P.M. in the Building "A" Conference Room at City Hall, 65950 Pierson Boulevard, Desert Hot Springs.

The ALRC reviews, considers and makes recommendations to the Planning Commission on certain development proposals and landscaping plans requiring a Development Review Permit and/or Design Review Permit.

APPOINTMENT PROCEDURE

Applicants shall be, to the extent feasible, licensed by the State of California in architecture, landscape architecture, civil engineering; or have expertise in urban planning.
