Free Curbside Cleanup for Desert Hot Springs Residents

Desert Hot Springs, California (April 19, 2013) – The next Desert Valley Disposal (DVD) Curbside Cleanup for the City of Desert Hot Springs will occur during the week of April 22, 2013 through April 26, 2013. This program is FREE to City residents and provides them with an opportunity to dispose of extra waste, yard trimmings or bulky items.

Residents are reminded of the following guidelines that apply to the program:

- DVD will collect up to two (2) items from each residence. Those two (2) items may be extra trash or yard waste in containers, bundles of yard waste, or bulky items like appliances, furniture or electronic products.
- All loose debris or yard waste must be contained or bundled. Tied bundles must not exceed four (4) feet in length and two (2) feet in diameter.
- No single container, bundle or bulky item may weigh more than 50 pounds.
- Construction and demolition debris will not be accepted.
- Residents are instructed to place their clean-up items at the street by 6:00 A.M. on Monday, April 22, 2013. Collection may occur any day during the week.
- Collection crews will canvas all streets and it is not necessary to call to schedule a pickup.
- Residents with more than two (2) items, or with construction and demolition debris, may make arrangements directly with DVD by calling (760) 329-5030.

Mayor Yvonne Parks stated, *“The curbside cleanup program is a valuable service for residents, providing a simple, no cost way to dispose of large, unwanted items and landscape trimmings. By utilizing this free service, residents are assisting in keeping their community blight-free.”*
