City of Desert Hot Springs to Host CV Link Route Identification Workshop

Desert Hot Springs, California (February 19, 2015) - The City of Desert Hot Springs will host two community workshops for the purpose of taking public testimony on the CV Link Project. The meetings are open to the public and the public is encouraged to attend.

CV Link will connect the Coachella Valley cities and three Indian reservations. Bicycles, pedestrians, and low-speed electric vehicles (LSEVs) will use the corridor to access employment, shopping, schools, friends, and recreational opportunities. LSEVs include golf carts and Neighborhood Electric Vehicles (NEVs) that can travel up to 25 mph. CV Link is the largest, most ambitious, project of its kind in the Southern California Association of Governments' (SCAG) Regional Transportation Plan, California, and the nation.

The objective of these two workshops is to discuss community preferences for possible route alternatives for the CV Link Project. City Manager Martín Magaña and Community Development Director Alex Meyerhoff will meet with the public to solicit community preferences regarding future routing of the CV Link project within the City of Desert Hot Springs.
