THE COMMUNITY POLICE ACADEMY

The Desert Hot Springs Police Department is pleased to offer a program designed to provide an overview at our department and the criminal justice system. The goal of the academy is to build upon the already strong relationship between the community and the department.

The Community Police Academy may be a series of classroom sessions, or a one day event taught with department personnel.

Participants will have the opportunity to meet the command staff, officers, department staff, volunteers, and others from the criminal justice community.

By offering this opportunity for our community to become directly involved in the police department, we believe it will enhance the quality of life in Desert Hot Springs by creating a rapport, and building relationships which lead to a more personal experience and strengthening our resolve to work together on community issues.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Participants are selected on a first come first served basis. Due to the limited seating, should a class fill up, your name will be placed on a waiting list for the next class. You will be contacted as soon as the next schedule is released to reassess your interest.

Every effort will be made to ensure each Academy class reflects a representative cross section of our community.

PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum age of 18 years (16 to 17 if accompanied by parent or legal guardian)
- Live or work in the city or near by county area
- No prior felony convictions
- No misdemeanor convictions in the last year

ACADEMY SCHEDULE

The Community Police Academy is held several times per year and will consist of approximately 10-20 residents. Class schedules vary from one day classes to eight week classes on various days or nights of the week.

Reservations are required for each participant and must be made generally *two weeks* prior to class.
